The success that Eliteform (ESPFA) have delivered speaks for itself and we are looking forward to creating this fantastic concept within our league.


AN INTRO SSPEA

STUDY.

WHY CHOOSE BTEC?



BTECs are the primary Level 3 qualification chosen and delivered at our academies. They are career-focused qualifications, designed to give you the skills you need to move into higher education or progress directly into employment.

A BTEC develops a range of industry-relevant knowledge and practical skills, which help you to prepare for, and progress in, your chosen career. Classroom-style teaching combined with project work and practical, work-related activities, help to develop a number of skills including teamwork, research, creative thinking and presentation skills; all of which are crucial for the workplace or Higher Education.

Chosen by over one million learners every year, BTEC offer a range of professional qualifications for anyone wishing to take their next step into the world of work to progress in their chosen careers. The primary difference between BTECs and A-Levels, for example, is the method of assessment. BTECs are graded via unit coursework throughout the duration of the programme, with the objective of preparing students for ongoing assessment in the working world.

THE BTEC QUALIFICATIONS WE OFFER?

The majority of our academies run two BTEC qualifications, both the Level 3 Diploma and Extended Diplomas in Sport, which are equivalent to two and three A-Levels respectively and accumulate UCAS points; the UK's tariff for applying to university.

As mentioned above, the BTECs we offer are assessed via unit coursework, which allows students to follow a clear structure throughout the duration of the programme and track their progress on the go. Both qualifications offer fantastic opportunities to progress academically and will equip you with vital skills to ultimately succeed in your chosen career. At some of our academies, we also have scope to run level two sporting qualifications, in place of the Level 3 BTECs. The BTEC in Sport qualifications we deliver will provide you with an in-depth knowledge into the ever-evolving world of sport. 
ANALYSIS OF SPORTS PERFORMANCE

ASSESSMENT PROCESS.

Our expert teachers will deliver each sport unit to the whole group and it will take approximately 4-6 weeks for you to complete each one.

All units will cover the essential content via a range of different learning and assessment activities, such as group tasks, presentations, individual research and practical performance.





At the end of each unit, you will be graded against the BTEC criteria and awarded either a Pass, Merit or Distinction grade. The higher grade you achieve in each unit will boost your overall qualification grade at the end of the programme and ultimately open up more options to you, to move forwards in your chosen field.

HOW FAR CAN YOU GO AFTER YOUR BTEC?

As mentioned throughout, there are a vast amount of opportunities open to you upon completion of one of our BTEC programmes. Our courses are designed with good working practices in mind and are centred around commitment and hard work, both of which will ultimately decide which grade you achieve at the end of year two.

For those hoping to progress into Higher Education, the UCAS table above provides a breakdown of what each qualification is worth in terms of UCAS points, which will give you an idea of which grades you'd need to achieve, in order to be accepted onto a university course, all of which will vary depending upon the institution you wish to join.

Upon completion of our BTEC programmes, some of our students choose to progress directly into employment and are highly attractive to employers, with a nationally-recognised Level 3 qualification under their belt.

Likewise, for any students who choose an apprenticeship route, they are able to fast track into a Higher-Level Apprenticeship, as opposed to starting afresh.

INTERESTING FACT

UK UNIVERSITY.

If you have achieved enough UCAS points within your BTEC qualification, you can join over 500,000 other students who apply for UK universities each year. We would usually advise this to be in a sport-related field, however some universities may also give you the option of a course in a completely unrelated subject, again, dependant on the number of UCAS points that you achieve.

US SCHOLARSHIP.

An increasingly attractive pathway for our academy students involves taking the leap across the Atlantic, to become a scholar in the USA. We work alongside scholarship industry experts, based both in the UK and abroad, to advise and guide you through the process, should you wish to study and play in America.



Currently the most popular pathway for our BTEC graduates, the ESPFA 'Blended Learning' degree programmes offer both flexibility and excellent employment prospects. These programmes allow you the opportunity to continue your education, progressing from Level 3 all the way up to Level 6, whilst still training full-time at your chosen football club.

These innovative courses, which blend online learning with hands-on work experience, are open to all learners achieving at least 56 UCAS points in their BTEC qualification. All ESPFA degrees are run in partnership with renowned universities, who have an excellent reputation in sports education, and offer BSc programmes in both Sports

Science and Sports Coaching.


